NOTES

These nine Introits and 21 Amens are primarily intended for use within the services of houses of worship. However, they have been composed with a second purpose in mind. This second purpose is to acquaint choirs with a more contemporary harmonic idiom than they may have been accustomed to. To this end, the Introits and Amens are arranged respectively in order of increasing difficulty in terms of harmonic dissonance and density and division of voices.

It is hoped that these little responses, by their brevity and by their gradual progression from simple to much more complex, will bring choirs fearlessly closer to trying some of the extraordinary masterpieces of the twentieth century, which many choirs may yet be reluctant to attempt.
